

A Message from Dr. Richard Kannwischer



Dear Peachtree Family,

Many organizations have mission statements that are more aspiration than reality. 2022 was a year that saw Peachtree Church make significant strides toward realizing our mission to join Christ daily in the restoration of all things. Your generous and sustained giving allowed us to make this mission a reality in our church, across our city, and around the world.

We walked through the Bible this past year during our Quest series, giving away 5,800 study Bibles. We celebrated with over 100 families as they brought their children to be baptized. We helped over 300 children and students achieve significant milestones in their faith. We welcomed 104 confirmands as new members of Peachtree Church. And this past September, we launched the Honour Academy with over 600 adults in attendance.

This past Spring, a 66 year old woman became a first-time homeowner when she moved into our 158th Atlanta Habitat for Humanity home. Schoolchildren experiencing food insecurity were fed with 4,000 Blessing Bags, lovingly filled by Peachtree members. Children of incarcerated parents were introduced to the Gospel at Camp Hope, Spanish-speaking students were tutored at La Amistad, and people in need of counseling found compassionate support at LifeGate.

And abroad, we continued to invest in ministries that build God's Kingdom in meaningful and practical ways. Ukrainian refugees were ministered to as a result of our \$297,000 Easter offering. Vegetable gardens in Malawi and Liberia flourished and fed entire villages as a result of 800 Peachtree volunteers packing 127,875 seed envelopes. And 290 students in Malawi and India continued pursuing their education, poised to become leaders in their community.

There are countless stories behind the numbers in this report, all of which point to the reality that God is on the move, needs are being met, and lives are being transformed. You continue to fund Peachtree Church's ministry at record levels, and for this I'm profoundly grateful. May we continue to partner with Christ daily in the restoration of all things.

- 1. The Peachtree Trust gave an additional \$229,724 to various Benevolences.
- 2. Belong Community classes gave an additional \$82,000 to Benevolences.
- 3. Total giving to Presbyterian Causes was \$608,993.
- 4. At the direction of the congregation and Session, the Personnel Committee reviewed compensation for all ordained & non-ordained staff and made adjustments where appropriate.
- 5. \$700,000 of the 2022 Net Revenue generated was applied to facility maintenance reserves in 2023 with the remainder to capital and personnel reserves.
- 6. In 2022, the church paid in full the church portion of outstanding debt and refinanced the remaining outstanding debt under Roswell Road Holdings into a single term loan.
