**STORY POINT:**  
Jesus cared for people.

**KEY PASSAGE:** John 3:16

**CHRIST CONNECTION:**  
Anyone who trusts in Jesus will be saved.

## BABIES

### BABY GOSPEL GEMS

Share these truths with your baby throughout the week!

- Jesus spoke to a Samaritan woman.
- The woman told people to come and hear Jesus.
- Many people believed Jesus is God's Son.

### BABY ACTIVITIES

#### WATER SENSORY EXPLORATION

Pour water and a few small, non-sharp household objects (glitter, noodles, leaves, etc.) into a large ziplock bag and seal it with duct tape. Sit on the floor with your baby and invite him to pat, play, and explore the water. You can even replicate this with sand or dirt for a different sensory activity!

**SAY:** Jesus spoke to a Samaritan woman who came to get water. **JESUS CARED FOR PEOPLE** and told her about God's plan. The woman told people to come and hear Jesus. Anyone who trusts in Jesus will be saved.

#### POUR WATER

Sit with your baby and provide a shallow bin with an inch of water. Give your baby a small cup and invite him to scoop and pour the water.

**SAY:** Jesus spoke to a Samaritan woman about living water, the Holy Spirit. **JESUS CARED FOR PEOPLE.** Many people believed Jesus is God's Son.

## TODDLERS

### BIBLE STORIES FOR TODDLERS

Share this story with your toddler throughout the week!

Jesus and His friends traveled to teach people about God. They stopped in Samaria. While Jesus sat at a well, a woman came to get water. Jesus said, "Give Me a drink." She was surprised. Jews did not like Samaritans! She asked, "You want a drink from me?" Jesus said, "If you knew who I am, you would ask Me for a drink. I would give you living water." She asked, "What is this living water?" Jesus was not talking about water you drink. Jesus was talking about God's Spirit. Jesus told the woman that He is the Messiah. The woman left her water jar and ran to the village. She told the people to come and hear Jesus. Many people believed that Jesus is the Messiah.

### TODDLER ACTIVITIES

#### JESUS LOVES

Gather age-appropriate magazines with pictures of people of different ages, abilities, and ethnicities or even pictures of your own family and friends! Encourage your toddler to look carefully at the pictures and point out which of the people Jesus loves. (all of them) Retell the Bible story.

**SAY: JESUS CARED FOR PEOPLE,** and He still does. Many people believed Jesus is God's Son. Anyone who trusts in Jesus will be saved!

#### SCOOP WATER

Tape gray or brown construction paper (or a paper bag) to a bucket so that it resembles a well. Provide ladles and cups for your toddler to play out drawing water. Talk about the Bible story as you toddler plays.

**SAY: JESUS CARED FOR PEOPLE.** Jesus spoke to a Samaritan woman at a well. Jesus was a Jew, and most Jews didn't like Samaritans. Jesus told the woman about God's plan, and the woman told people to come and hear Jesus.
