## BABIES

### BABY GOSPEL GEMS

Share these truths with your baby throughout the week!

- Jesus healed a man who could not see.
- Jesus' friends thought the man did something wrong to be blind.
- Jesus said the man was blind to show God's power.

### BABY ACTIVITIES

#### READ IN COLOR

Find your baby's favorite, colorful picture books and Bible storybooks. Read the books and point out the vivid colors. Retell the Bible story.

**SAY:** *Jesus healed a man who could not see. God created people for His glory. Jesus said the man was blind to show God's power.*

#### "MUDDY" SENSORY PLAY

Provide a smock or bib, heavyweight paper, and a dab of chocolate pudding for your baby in a high chair. Lead your baby to spread and explore the "mud" on the paper.

**SAY:** *Jesus healed a man who could not see by putting mud on his eyes. The mud did not have power; Jesus did! God created people for His glory, or praise. Jesus helps us see what is true about God.*

## TODDLERS

### BIBLE STORIES FOR TODDLERS

Share this story with your toddler throughout the week!

Jesus saw a man who was born blind—unable to see. His friends asked, "Jesus, who sinned to make this man blind, him or his parents?" Jesus said, "This man cannot see so people can see God's power." Then Jesus spit on the ground, made mud, and put it on the man's eyes. He said, "Go and wash." The man obeyed, and he could see! People asked the man who had helped him see. The teachers were upset because Jesus healed him on the Sabbath. The man said, "One thing I know is that I was blind, but now I can see."

### TODDLER ACTIVITIES

#### DIRT PLAY

Provide a small tub with dirt from your yard or sand. Give your toddler shovels, pails, molds, and other items to play in the dirt. Tell the Bible story as your toddler plays.

**SAY:** *Jesus healed a man who could not see by making mud out of dirt and putting it on his eyes. God created people for His glory.*

#### "MUDDY" SNACK

Serve a chocolate pudding cup with dark cookie crumbs on top to your toddler at snack time. Talk about how the snack looks like dirt. Tell the Bible story as your toddler eats.

**SAY:** *Jesus healed a man who could not see. God created people for His glory. Jesus said the man was blind to show God's power.*
