
INSTRUCTIONS: Draw a line connecting each coin to whose face is on the coin.

I ask no questions, but seek an answer. What am I?






Can You Spot the Truth?

A *beefalo* is part bison, part cow.




Bloodhounds can follow a scent that is 40 days old.




The Book of Psalms contains 150 psalms.
